(1) Guide dogs help blind people get around. To do this, a guide dog must recognize and avoid obstacles, and be loyal ( 2 ) the handler.

(3) In addition, a guide dog must know that it should disobey any command ( 4 ) would put the handler in danger. This ability, selective disobedience, is perhaps the most amazing thing about guide dogs. This capacity is extremely important at intersections. Dogs cannot distinguish the color of traffic lights, so the handler listens to the flow of traffic to figure ( 5 ) when the light has changed and then gives the command “forward.” If there is no danger, the dog proceeds across the road in a straight line. But if there are cars approaching, the dog (6)[① the handler go ② is gone ③ until the danger ④ won't let] and then follows the command to go forward.

Working ( 7 ) a guide dog requires it to stay in good physical and mental shape, so guide dogs typically retire just before ( 8 ) enter old age. When a guide dog retires, the guide dog will be adopted by someone else. Former guide dogs are extremely intelligent and friendly – (9) who wouldn't want one? Giving a retired guide dog a loving home is an excellent way to help ( 10 ) these amazing animals for a lifetime of hard, important work.
