- (1)Studies done over the past several years show some very clear distinctions in the way men and women use language. For example, baby girls usually talk (2), and more, than baby boys. This is not surprising since human language is primarily controlled by the left side of the brain, and current research shows that testosterone slows the development of the left side of the brain while speeding the growth of the (3).

This difference in brain development may be one reason (4) the conversation styles of men and women are also different. Studies in the U.S. show that men tend to speak in a more straightforward manner. They say (5) they mean directly, so it is often easier to understand exactly what they want. Women are more likely to have a give-and-take style of conversation based on questions and answers and asking for opinions. Therefore, while a woman may discuss (6)[① would like ② to see ③ which movie ④ she], a man is more likely to simply tell you that The Lord of the Rings is the best choice.

Men's straightforward manner of speaking may be connected to a tendency to be (7) physical and (8) verbal in general. (9)The hormone testosterone may again be responsible for the difference. Both boys and girls can be guilty of bullying, but while the twelve-year-old boy is more (10) to engage in a physical fight, a girl of the same age is more (11) to use words to emotionally hurt a classmate.
